Lord, bless and guide Elizabeth our Queen; give wisdom to all in authority; and direct this and every nation in the ways of justice and of peace; that all may honour one another, and seek the common good.

In this time of anxiety, give us strength to comfort the fearful, to tend the sick, and to assure the isolated of our love, and your love. God of compassion, be close to those who are ill, afraid or in isolation. In their loneliness, be their consolation; in their anxiety, be their hope; in their darkness, be their light.

Gracious Lord, comfort and heal all those who suffer in body, mind, or spirit; give them courage and hope in their troubles; and bring them the joy of your salvation. Lord, in your mercy...

Reader: Lord, be with those who have recently lost a loved one. We pray for all those who help the bereaved – funeral directors, befrienders, those who work in crematoriums and cemeteries, those who conduct funeral services and minister to families and friends of those who have died. We remember those from the past who have died in the faith of Christ at this time of year [**PAUSE**]... According to your promises, grant us with them a share in your eternal kingdom. Lord, in your mercy...

Reader: Finally, we pray for ourselves. We are not people of fear: we are people of courage. We are not people who protect our own safety: we are people who protect our neighbours' safety. We are not people of greed: we are people of generosity. We are your people God, giving and loving, wherever we are, whatever it costs, for as long as it takes, wherever you call us. Lord God, you are always with us. You are with us in the day and in the night. You are with us when we are happy and when we are sad. You are with us when we are healthy and when we are ill. You are with us when we are peaceful and when we are worried. Help us to remember that you love us and are with us in everything today, tomorrow and for all eternity. Christ be with us, Christ within us, Christ behind us, Christ before us, Christ beside us, Christ to win us, Christ to comfort and restore us.
